PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY. NOTHING IS TO BE REMOVED FROM HOME UNLESS APPROVED BY INSPECTOR.

Please remove from the treatment area the following items:

- ✓ People, plants, and pets, aerosol cans. Fish and/or tanks prior to service.
- ✓ Fresh fruits and vegetables, chocolates, wines, liquors, artificial sweeteners, medicines and vitamins, wax based or paraffin-based items such as: make-up, lipstick, candles, wax figurines, crayons must be placed in a refrigerator.
- ✓ Guns and ammunition.
- ✓ Have all Antique furniture with finish or fragile glue points inspected for possible removal from heat.
- ✓ ALL Vinyl miniblinds. Any vinyl items.
- ✓ Wooden and stringed musical instruments, please leave the cases.
- ✓ While saving your furniture is one of our primary goals, if items are severely infested disposal may be required, do not throw away any furniture unless advised by our inspector.

Prior to treatment complete the following:

- ✓ **Reduce** Clutter. Closet floors **must** be cleaned out. **Nothing** under beds. **Eliminate Floor Clutter**
- ✓ Vacuum Floors, after vacuuming put a small amount of baby powder (talc powder) into vacuum cleaner.
- ✓ Strip all beds remove linens and hot water wash and high heat dry.
- ✓ Also please remove batteries from smoke detectors.
- ✓ Power down and unplug Computers and all other sensitive electronics. Not including kitchen appliances.
- ✓ Picture frames assembled with hot-melt glue should be removed from the wall. All other wall items may remain.
- ✓ Remove clothing from all dressers then "process them" by washing & drying on hottest setting. Place processed clothes into NEW BAG and store out of the treatment areas. Clothes in closets may remain **IF HANGING (DON'T OVER FILL)**, all folded clothes in closet must be processed. Clothing items sensitive to "processing" may be hung in closet to be heat treated.
- ✓ Place smaller clutter items such as shoes and toys into an aerated laundry basket. Use gallon size ZIP-LOCK bags for small loose items laying on/in dressers and night stands. Place labeled bags on counter or table in kitchen.
- ✓ Waterbeds must be drained and removed. Disassemble frame to achieve proper temperature. Airbeds must be partially deflated to avoid damage. Electric pump airbeds must be partially deflated, disconnect air supply, and unplug power.
- ✓ Set home furnace to 90 degrees on service day morning upon waking, then set to FAN once we arrive.
- ✓ **ALL occupants must be ready to leave immediately upon our arrival. Each ONLY taking a change of clothing.**
